Decision to disperse the practice list:

Dr Majeed, Bloomsbury Health Centre, Bloomsbury Health Centre, 63 Rupert Street, B7 5BT

Following on from the Consultation that we carried out with Dr Majeed's patients from Monday 26th August 2019 to Monday 23rd September 2019 where registered patients of Dr Majeed's practice and neighbouring providers were invited to share their views on the future of this practice.

Patients and providers were invited to share their views and experiences by;

- Taking part in an online survey
- Taking part in an offline survey
- Attending one of three public meetings or a provider meeting at the POD

All completed surveys, questions and answers from the public meeting were analysed and compiled into a report which was presented to the Primary Care Co Commissioning Committee (PCCC) on Thursday 3rd October 2019. The purpose of this Committee is to ensure that the CCG commissions (buys) local Primary Care Services that are safe, effective and provide high quality care to our patients. They are made up of several representatives consisting of Doctors, NHS Managers and Lay Representatives. **After careful consideration this Committee made this decision to disperse the practice list size which means that patients will now need to register with another practice by 31st January 2020.**

The PCCC made this decision based on the following;

- The best interests of the patients
- We believe from previous experience a re-procurement of the current list size for Dr Majeed's Practice would not attract interest from other GP providers
